

Dysgu gwersi o ymateb y gymuned i COVID-19 yng Nghymru

Learning lessons from the community response to COVID-19 in Wales

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Ymateb dan arweiniad y gymuned i'r Pandemig / Community-led response to the pandemic

- Ochr yn ochr â'r pandemig a'i gamau rheoli, cafwyd camau gweithredu dan arweiniad y gymuned gan wirfoddolwyr newydd i gefnogi pobl a oedd yn agored i niwed.
- Mae cofnodi'r hyn a ddysgir o'r cynnydd sylweddol mewn camau gweithredu dan arweiniad y gymuned yn ystod y pandemig COVID-19, yn hollbwysig er mwyn paratoi unigolion a chymunedau'n well i ymateb ac addasu'n gadarnhaol i ddigwyddiadau digynsail byd-eang yn y dyfodol.
- The pandemic and its control measures, were accompanied by emergent community-led action to support the vulnerable.
- Capturing the learning from the upsurge in community-led action during the COVID-19 pandemic, is of key importance to better equip individuals and communities to respond and positively adapt to future globally unprecedented events.

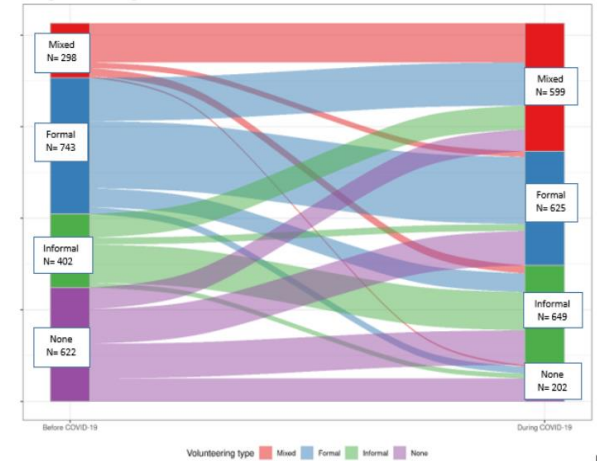
Methodoleg / Methodology

- Arolwg meintiol ledled Cymru ar gyfranogi mewn gweithgareddau gwirfoddol cymunedol, a'r galluogwyr a'r rhwystrau
- Cyfweiliadau ansoddol lled-strwythuredig ar gamau gweithredu dan arweiniad y gymuned a'u cynaliadwyedd ar ôl y pandemig ymhlith rhanddeiliaid gwahanol ar draws y system
- A quantitative survey across Wales on participation in community voluntary activities, and enablers and barriers.
- Qualitative semi-structured interviews on community-led action and sustainability post pandemic amongst different stakeholders across the system

Negeseuon Allweddol / Key messages

Crynodeb o'r pwyntiau allweddol

- Roedd nodweddion y gwirfoddolwyr yn ystod y pandemig a gymerodd ran yn yr arolwg yn cynnwys y canlynol: roedd dros dri chwarter yn fenywod, dros eu hanner yn 45-64 oed, dros 60% wedi'u haddysgu i lefel gradd, o'r tri chwintel â'r amddifadedd lleiaf.
- Gwelwyd newidiadau mewn ymddygiad gwirfoddoli cyn ac yn ystod pandemig. Parhaodd llawer o'r rhai a oedd eisoes yn wirfoddolwyr gweithgar i wirfoddoli yn ystod y pandemig.
- Estynnodd llawer o wirfoddolwyr gweithgar eu gweithgareddau gwirfoddoli hefyd, ar draws grwpiau ffurfiol ac anffurfiol.
- Roedd yna hefyd wirfoddolwyr gweithgar a gamodd yn ôl yn ystod y pandemig, gan i rai orfod gwarchod eu hunain.
- Roedd tua chwarter y gwirfoddolwyr yn newydd i wirfoddoli, gyda llawer yn parhau i weithio drwy gydol y pandemig yn llawn amser neu'n rhan-amser.



Summary of key points

- Characteristics of surveyed volunteers during the pandemic included: over three quarters were females, over half were those aged 45-64 years old, over 60% educated to degree level, from the three least deprived quintiles.
- Changes in volunteering behaviour before and during pandemic were observed. Many of those who were already active volunteers, continued during the pandemic.
- Many active volunteers also extended their volunteering activities, across both formal and informal groups.
- There were also active volunteers who stepped back during pandemic, some having to shield.
- About a quarter of the volunteer population was new to volunteering, with many continuing to work throughout the pandemic in full-time or part-time capacity.
- A shift in demographic profile has been noted, with the emerging volunteers being younger than the usual profile.

Perthnasedd i iechyd y cyhoedd / **Relevance to public health**

- Wrth adfer o'r pandemig, bydd yn bwysig myfyrio ar ganfyddiadau'r astudiaeth hon ochr yn ochr â thystiolaeth sy'n dod i'r amlwg ar gamau gweithredu ac ymateb cymunedol, er mwyn deall yn well sut i greu amgylchedd galluogol ar gyfer camau gweithredu dan arweiniad y gymuned; grymuso cymunedau ledled Cymru a chynyddu gwirfoddoli lleol a chyfranogiad cymdeithasol, a deall sut y gall cymunedau a phob sector barhau i weithio'n llwyddiannus mewn partneriaeth.
- In recovery from the pandemic, it will be important to reflect on the findings from this study alongside emerging evidence on community-led action and response, to better understand how to create an enabling environment for community-led action; empowering communities across Wales and increasing local volunteerism and social participation, and understanding how communities and all sectors can continue successful partnership-working.
